

March 26, 2023 Judica Sunday, the 5th Sunday in Lent Beloved in the Lord,

Today we entered the end of the Lenten season, which the church has called "Passiontide." By the time you receive this, we will likely be on the verge of Palm Sunday and Holy Week, when our time spent in confession and meditation of our Lord's Passion intensifies.

I have always loved Holy Week, especially marking the events of Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday, and Easter Sunday, as if I were there, struggling alongside the disciples, following my Lord throughout His Passion, laying Him in the tomb, and waiting for the morning.

In addition, remembering what happened on those days *sanctifies* my experience of them. What I mean is this: Thursday is no longer "just Thursday" and Friday is not "just Friday." Rather, on Thursday I am reminded, "This is the day when my Lord instituted for me His most precious Holy Supper. Friday is the day when He gave His life into death for my sins." These remembrances—taking time to attend the services on these days during Holy Week—set the days apart. They are faith-strengthening!

What I have discovered, though, is that one doesn't need to wait each year for Holy Week to come around. You can mark these days as special every week! You can remember on each day of the week the loving-kindness which God has shown unique to that day.

One of my favorite, newly found resources for doing this is the *Lutheran Prayer Companion*. It's a new translation of an old collection of Lutheran prayers and hymns, originally compiled for home devotional use. In the back is a collection of Morning Hymns for each day of the week by J. Olearius. Here are a few examples:

Friday	Saturday	Sunday
This day was Adam given breath,	This day Christ rested for a time	Praise God! For Sunday now has come,
Who into all the world brought death;	When He was buried for my crime,	A new week gladdens Christendom;
This day by death God's very Son,	And thus prepared a resting-place	This day God first created light,
Secured for us the heav'nly throne.	In heaven's blessed realm of grace.	This day Christ bro't true life to sight.

What a blessing it is to pause in Holy Week to mark the days of our Lord's Passion and Resurrection! And what a blessing to mark each week and each day, remembering and giving thanks *specifically* for what the Lord has done! May the Lord bless you this Passiontide and always!




