January 25, 2023 The Feast of the Conversion of St. Paul

Beloved in the Lord,

This Sunday (January 29th) we will hear again how our Lord took three of His disciples up the mountain and then was transfigured before them. Moses and Elijah join Him in conversation, discussing His "Exodus," referring already to the cross. As Jesus comes down the mountain He teaches His bewildered disciples that He must be crucified, and He sets His face for Jerusalem—to the cross!

And so, the season of preparation for Easter begins once again. The first few Sundays after the Transfiguration of our Lord (the "Gesima" Sundays) ease us into the season of Lent. Then, by February 22nd this year, Ash Wednesday begins in earnest the season of fasting, self-denial, and growth in Christ.

One healthy part of our Lenten discipline is the additional Wednesday night services, at which we set aside extra time to gather and meditate upon God's Word. The theme of our Lenten meditation this year will be: "The Seven Words from the Cross." Each week we will meditate upon one of our Lord's last seven statements from the cross prior to His death and resurrection.

For this series of sermons and services, Pastor Raddatz will rotate with Pastor Bishop from St. John's Lutheran in Pekin so that you will hear a sermon from Pastor Raddatz one week and then one from Pastor Bishop the next (see schedule below). May the meditation of our hearts upon the Word of our Lord be acceptable to Him this Lenten season.
