Giving in April was in line with what was projected while expenses were a bit lower than budgeted. The General Fund balance at the end of March was \$178,027.

Thrivent Challenge Grant: In April, Trinity was notified that Washington Intermediate School had started a "Mons Who Care" program. A \$250.00 grant will be sent to the school from the Thrivent Challenge Grant Fund. This matches the grants sent to Edison Junior High, Broadmoor Junior High, and Wilson Intermediate schools in March.

Estates and Bequests: \$14,993.00 was received from the Mildred Cordes Estate and placed into the Estates and Bequests Fund. Keeping in line with the previous actions, the Church Council voted to send \$1,500.00 (10%) to Good Shepherd Lutheran School to apply to their building debt.

Let us give thanks to the Lord for His continued blessings and pray that we may continue to be faithful stewards until the day of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.



May 23, 2023 Tuesday—The 7th Week of Easter Beloved in the Lord,

This month I am continuing the newsletter series: Frequently Asked Questions about "Closed Communion." Closed communion is the practice of inviting some to the Table of our Lord while keeping back others (or welcoming them only for a blessing). Last month I showed from Scripture one of the primary reasons that we observe this practice: in responsible love for our neighbors. As we saw from 1 Corinthians 11:29, though anyone who receives at our altar will receive the Body and Blood of Christ, not everyone will necessarily receive the Lord's Supper to his benefit. If we do not know whether someone believes that the true Body and Blood (not only bread and wine) are distributed at our altar, then we are obligated out of love for them to keep them from receiving.

However, another question frequently arises when it comes to Closed Communion: What if someone says he believes that the true Body and Blood of Christ are present and received in the Lord's Supper but he is of a different confession (church/denomination)? Shouldn't he still receive at our altar, since he says that he discerns the Body and Blood of Christ there?

To answer this question, first, let's go back to 1 Corinthians 11, this time to look at verse 26: "For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes."

In this verse, St. Paul teaches us that when we receive Jesus' Body and Blood, we are also "proclaiming" His death. That is, when we take the Lord's Supper together, we are also *confessing* the Gospel together. So, the Lord's Supper is also a confession of our faith in Christ and His Gospel.

St. Paul gives a similar principle in 1 Corinthians 10:18. He writes, "Consider the people of Israel: are not those who eat the sacrifices participants in the altar?" He is saying that, in the Old Testament when Israelites received the sacrificial food from the altar, they were also "participating" in that altar. In other words, they were taking part in what was happening there, what was being confessed there, what was believed there. The principle expressed is this: by sharing at any given altar, you share in whatever they do and believe at that altar. Paul goes on to say, therefore, that you should not and must not, participate at God's altar and at another altar.

Paul is applying this principle to the Lord's Table. He is saying that you must not share in the Lord's Supper while also sharing in another altar that opposes the Word of God. This also applies in our day when it comes to other Christian denominations. Someone must not take at an altar that confesses against the Real Presence of Christ's Body and Blood and then come and take communion at our altar. This is true even if he says that he believes what we teach. To confess one thing about the Lord but then to contradict it by one's actions is neither good nor safe. By closing the table to such a Christian, we again do a service of love. We are calling him to repentance for living contrary to God's Word. We are teaching him that what Christ says about His Body and Blood in the Supper is not an indifferent matter or a mere opinion. We are encouraging him to a more faithful witness that confesses in a straightforward and clear manner the truth of God's Word.
